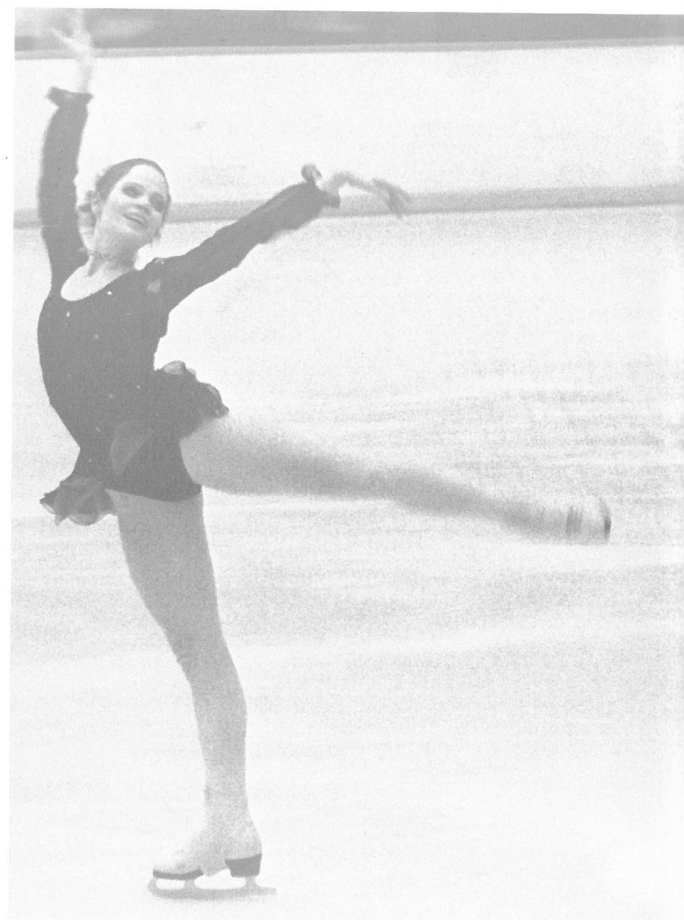
Ice Theatre is a home for skaters and audiences who thrill to the beauty and power of this Twentieth Century American art form.

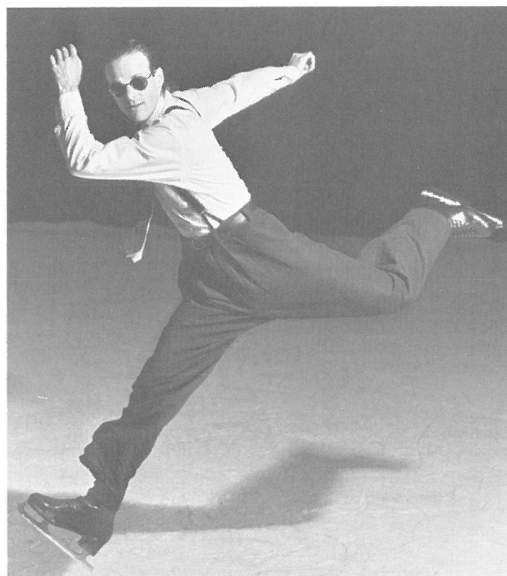
