

ABOUT THE COMPANY

1984: A landmark year in the professional life of Moira North, and in the development of figure skating as a performing art.

Moira, a Canadian Gold Medalist, had toured with Holiday on Ice and Ice Follies. In 1984 she returned to skating as a member of the professional staff of New York City's Sky Rink and as Director of the Skating Club of New York's Junior Club. Along with Patrick Dean, another instructor at Sky Rink, she joined forces with ballet choreotrapher Mark Bogaerts' to create "Heaven and Hell' with music by Vangelis, and went on to place first in the 1984 World Professional free dance competition

in Jaca, Spain. This collaboration with Bogaerts led later that year to the founding of Ice Theatre of New York, to which Moira now devotes her professional life, serving as Director.

Ice Theatre of New York was conceived as a dance company with ice as its dance medium. It is a non-profit company of skating artists, which from the beginning attracted not only a core troupe of professional skaters

Marc Bogaerts is currently choreographing for the State Opera Ballet in Berlin, Germany. He has worked extensively with competitive figure skaters throughout the United States and Canada since his initial work with Ice Theatre of New York.

dedicated to the company's ideals, but also members and guest performers such as John Curry, JoJo Starbuck, Ken Shelley, Judy Blumberg, Michael Siebert, and Katherine Healy.

In 1988 the first of two events critical to the developing history of Ice Theatre took place. That spring, Moira secured the talents of Rob McBrien, who had been John Curry's ensemble director, to be Ice Theatre's Artistic Director. Two years later, she and Rob brought Gary Beacom to New York for his production of Hard Edge. This production established Gary's star status in the United States and began his continuing association with the Ice Theatre company, along with that of his partner, Gia Guddat.

The Ice Theatre ensemble has an original and sophisticated repertory that includes such pieces as "Different Trains", choreographed by Rob McBrien to music by Steve Reich, and "Angel: Part I", choreographed by Ann Carlson to a Tibetan chant, featuring large flags used as choreographic props by the skaters. The company's work has attracted a number of prominent modern dance choreographers, including Carlson, Laura Dean and Rick Merrill.

Ice Theatre features as its educational centerpiece the Plié Power Workshop, based on the ideas of John Curry and developed and directed by Rob McBrien. The essence of the workshop has been correctly described in the *New Yorker* magazine as "a concern with making the skater sensitive to the

edges of the skating blade as instruments for the projection of expression' and by dance critic Anita Finkel as "...the foundation upon which a real art of skating can be built" (New Dance Quarterly). This theme carries also into the essence of the ensemble performances.

In talking about her vision for Ice Theatre, Moira likes to refer to an article by the dance critic John Martin in the March 13, 1938 edition of the *New York Times*. Martin notes:

"With the ice ballets of Sonja Henie, Maribel Vinsion, Karl Schaeffer and scores of others attracting tremendous audiences on the screen, in Madison Square Garden, in armories all over the country, and even in semi-tropical Florida, a strong suspicion arises that the rink is producing dance developments which may be of considerable interest before they are through."

Moira is fascinated at Martin's prescience of what she and Rob believe is the heart of their philosophy of skating when he observed that, "in effect, the addition of the blade under the foot serves to increase the dancer's range in terms of horizontal space, in something of the same way that the addition of the box-toe to the ballet slipper in the last century increased her range in terms of vertical space." Moira and Rob believe that Ice Theatre is today doing what Martin called for over fifty years ago. Drawing other creative choreographers from both the dance and figure skating disciplines to work with Rob, Ice Theatre has in fact pro-

duced "a repertoire of distinction."

The same standards of artistic vision and technical skill are applied in Ice Theatre's apprentice program, which is not only an extension of the company's educational mission, but also a source of new performers for the company. Beth Woronoff is a talented young apprentice who participated in the program this past summer, who will perform this evening in "Lumiere". She writes about her experiences:

"I look at the ice as a medium which holds in infinite number of unexplored channels. Once there is a basic understanding of what the ice and one's body can do, and a trust in that body's memroy is established, creativity can flourish...Ice Theatre of New York has taken me beyond my single form and its contact with the ice. I am now part of an ensemble, which interacts not only with the ice, but with the other bodies around me... In unison, more people create more power."

Ice Theatre's 1991-92 schedule includes performances in a concert series at the Rink at Rockefeller Plaza; other performances in New York City at Sky Rink, with Dancing in the Streets, and at the city's public rinks; performances at the Walter Brown Arena in Boston with the Dance Umbrella; and at the Flynn Theatre in Burlington, Vermont. Plans are also underway for performances at winter festivals in Andorra and in Canada. This 1991-92 performance schedule will be accompanied by the development of a television production for the 1992-93 season.
