ICE THEATRE PERFORMANCE CLUBS Skaters are taught to use clear and articulate movements to express a wide range of emotions. Such clarity is achieved by learning some of the basics of ballet and modern dance, such as plies and port de bras. Classes culminate in the performance of a new work created specifically for each group.

Children's Performance Club This club is open to children of all ages and levels. It offers an opportunity for skaters to begin developing performance skills at the start of their training. Many of these young skaters go on to join the Junior Performance Club and then to apprentice with the professional company.

Junior Performance Club These skaters are potential apprentices for the professional company. While many of them train to compete in regional competitions, this club offers to them a venue to perform artistic ensemble skating.

Senior Performance Club This performance group is comprised of adults from all backgrounds. Some began skating at a young age, other have picked up skating in recent years. All are here because they enjoy skating artistic group works.
